ANGER

ARE YOU GIVING THE DEVIL A GUESTROOM?

ICE BREAKER... What makes you angry? What really sets you off?

Do hot tempers run in your family?

"In your <u>anger do not sin</u>": Do not let the sun go down while you are **still angry**, and do not give the devil a **foothold**. Ephesians 4:26-27

The word *foothold* is *topos* (top'-os); *opportunity*, location, place, *room*.

Sinful anger gives the devil *opportunity* and a *guestroom* in our house.

Then the LORD said to Cain, "Why are you <u>angry</u>? Why is your face downcast? If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, <u>sin is crouching at your DOOR</u>; it desires to <u>have you</u>, but you must <u>master it</u>." Genesis 4:6-7

WRONG WAYS WE HANDLE ANGER

SPEWERS EXPRESS IT.

A *fool* gives *full* <u>vent to his anger</u>, but a wise man keeps himself *under control*. Prov 29:11

A *quick-tempered* man does *foolish things*. Proverbs 14:17

STEWERS SUPPRESS IT.

When *I kept silent*, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long. Psalm 32:3

The older brother became *angry* and *refused to go in*... Luke 15:28

WHAT DO I DO WITH MY ANGER?

Anger is like FIRE! (put it out or fan it!)

> **SINFUL ANGER: PUT IT OUT!** (douse it with the water of the Spirit)

Starting a quarrel is like breaching a dam; so *drop the matter* before a dispute breaks out. Proverbs 17:14

"Everyone should be quick to *listen*, slow to *speak* and *slow to become angry*, for man's anger does not bring about the righteous life that God desires."

James 1:19-20

> SANCTIFIED ANGER: FAN THE FLAME! (fan it with the wind of the Spirit)

(Jesus) looked around at them in <u>anger</u> and, deeply distressed at their stubborn hearts... said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." He stretched it out, and **his hand was completely <u>restored</u>**. Mark 3:5

Sanctified anger will always result in **Godly actions**! We can always tell the **source of our anger** by what it **leads us to do**.
