1 Samuel 16 ¹ Now the LORD said to Samuel... Fill your horn with oil and go; I will send you to Jesse the Bethlehemite, because <u>I have chosen a king for Myself among his sons</u>." ³ ... you shall anoint for Me the one whom I designate to you." ⁶ When they entered, he looked at Eliab and thought, "Surely the LORD's anointed is *standing* before Him." ⁷ But the LORD said to Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance or at the height of his stature, because I have rejected him; <u>for God does not see as</u> man sees, <u>since man looks at the outward appearance</u>, <u>but the LORD looks at the heart</u>." ¹³ So

Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers; and <u>the Spirit of the</u> <u>LORD rushed upon David from that day forward</u>. NASU (*David was probably between 10-15 years old*)

1 Samuel 30 1 Then it happened, when David and his men came to Ziklag on the third day, that the Amalekites had carried out an attack on the Negev and on Ziklag, and had overthrown Ziklag and burned it with fire; ² and they took captive the women and all who were in it, from the small to the great, without killing anyone, and drove them off and went their way. ³ When David and his men came to the city, behold, it was burned with fire, and their wives, their sons, and their daughters had been taken captive.⁴ Then David and the people who were with him raised their voices and wept until there was no strength in them to weep. ⁶ Also, David was in great distress because the people spoke of stoning him, for all the people were embittered, each one because of his sons and his daughters. But David felt strengthened in the LORD his God.⁸ And David inquired of the LORD, saying, "Shall I pursue this band of raiders? Will I overtake them?" And He said to him, "Pursue, for you will certainly overtake them, and you will certainly rescue (recover all) everyone." 9 So David left, he and the six hundred men who were with him, and they came to the brook Besor, where some who were left behind stayed. ¹⁰ But David pursued, he and four hundred men, for two hundred who were too exhausted to cross the brook Besor stayed behind. ¹⁸ So David recovered all that the Amalekites had taken...¹⁹ And nothing of theirs was missing, whether small or great, sons or daughters, plunder, or anything that they had taken for themselves; David brought it all back. **2 Samuel 1**¹ Now it came about after the death of Saul, when David had returned from the slaughter of the Amalekites, that David stayed two days in Ziklag.² And on the third day... 2 Samuel 2 ¹ Then it came about afterward that **David inquired of the Lord**, saying, "Shall I go up to one of the cities of Judah?" And the Lord said to him, "Go up." So David said, "Where shall I go up?" And He said, "To Hebron." ² So David went up there... ³ And David brought up his men who were with him, each with his household; and they settled in the cities of Hebron. ⁴ Then the men of Judah came, and there they anointed David king over the house of Judah. 2 Samuel 5³...then they anointed David king over Israel.⁴ David was thirty years old when he became king, and he reigned for forty years.⁵ At Hebron he reigned over Judah for seven years and six months, and in Jerusalem he reigned for thirty-three years over all Israel and Judah.
