

YOU WERE BORN AGAIN FOR THE GLORY OF GOD Children Are Born For The Glory Of God!

Glory: *chabod* (kah-vohd); Strong's #3519: Weightiness; that which is substantial or heavy; glory, honor, splendor, power, wealth, authority, magnificence, fame, dignity, riches, and excellency. The root of *chabod* is *chabad*, "to be heavy, glorious, notable," or "to be renowned." In the OT, "heaviness" represented honor and substance, while "lightness" was equated with vanity, instability, temporariness, and emptiness. *Chabod* is God's glory, not only His honor, renown, and majesty, but also His visible splendor, which filled Solomon's temple and will someday fill the Earth. *From the Spirit Filled Bible*

Isaiah 6¹ In the year that King Uzziah died, I clearly saw the Lord. He was seated on his exalted throne, towering high above me. His long, flowing robe *of splendor* spread throughout the temple. ² Standing above him were the angels of flaming fire, each with six wings: with two wings they covered their faces *in reverence*, with two wings they covered their feet, and with two wings they flew. ³ And one called out to another, saying: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God, Commander of Angel Armies! *The whole earth is filled with his glory*!" ⁴ The thunderous voice of the fiery angels caused the foundations of the thresholds to tremble as <u>the cloud of glory filled the temple</u>! TPT

Habakkuk 2¹⁴ For as the waters fill the sea, the earth will be filled with an awareness of the glory of the Lord. NLT

Isaiah 43 ⁴ Since you are *cherished and* precious in my eyes, and because <u>I love</u> <u>you dearly and want to honor you</u>, I willingly give up nations in exchange for you—a man to save your life. TPT

Ephesians 5 ²⁶ to make us holy and pure, cleansing us through the showering of the pure water of the Word of God. ²⁷ <u>All that he does in us is designed to make us a mature church for his pleasure</u>, <u>until we become a source of praise to him</u>—glorious and radiant, <u>beautiful and holy</u>, <u>without fault or flaw</u>. TPT

NOTE: The Greek word for "radiance" (*endoxos*) can also mean "gorgeous," "honorable," "esteemed," "splendid," "infused with glory." This is what Christ's love will do to you.

Colossians 1 ²⁶ There is a divine mystery—a secret surprise that has been concealed from the world for generations, but now it's being revealed, unfolded and manifested for every holy believer to experience. ²⁷ Living within you is the Christ who floods you with the expectation of glory! This mystery of Christ, embedded within us, becomes a heavenly treasure chest of hope filled with the riches of glory for his people, and God wants everyone to know it! TPT

2 Corinthians 3 ¹⁸ We can all draw close to him with the veil removed from our faces. And with no veil we all become like mirrors <u>who brightly reflect the glory of the Lord Jesus</u>. <u>We are being</u> <u>transfigured into his very image as we move from one brighter level of glory to another</u>. And this glorious transfiguration comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit. TPT

Psalm 127 ³ <u>Children are God's love-gift</u>; <u>they are heaven's generous reward</u>. ⁴ Children born to a young couple will one day rise to protect and provide for their parents. ⁵ Happy will be the couple who has many of them! A household full of children will not bring shame on your name but victory when you face your enemies, for <u>your offspring will have influence and honor to prevail</u> <u>on your behalf</u>! TPT

Proverbs 22 ⁶ <u>Dedicate your children to God</u> and point them in the way that they should go, and the values they've learned from you will be with them for life. TPT

1 Samuel 1 ²⁷ For this boy I prayed, and the LORD has given me my petition which I asked of Him. ²⁸ So I have also dedicated him to the LORD; as long as he lives he is dedicated to the LORD." And he worshiped the LORD there. NASB

Isaiah 49 ²⁵ But Yahweh says: "The prey will be freed from the mighty warrior and captives will be rescued from a conqueror! <u>For I will fight with those who fight with you</u>, <u>and *I myself will save your children*</u>. TPT

Isaiah 54 ¹⁰ Even if the mountains were to crumble and the hills disappear, my heart of steadfast, faithful love will never leave you, and my covenant of peace with you will never be shaken," says **Yahweh**, **whose love and compassion** *will never give up on you*. ¹¹ "You unhappy one, storm-tossed and troubled, I am ready to rebuild you with precious stones and embed your foundation with sapphires. ¹³ <u>All your children will be taught by Yahweh</u>, <u>and great will be their peace</u> <u>and prosperity</u>. ¹⁴ You will be established in righteousness. Oppression—be far from them! Fear— be far from them! Yes, terror will not come near you, nor will you be afraid. ¹⁵ If anyone dares to stir up strife against you, it is not from me! Those who challenge you will go down in defeat. ¹⁷ *But I promise you*, <u>no weapon meant to hurt you will succeed</u>, <u>and you will refute every accusing</u> <u>word spoken against you</u>. <u>This promise is the inheritance of Yahweh's servants</u>, and their vindication is from me," says Yahweh. TPT

Isaiah 58 ⁸ Then my favor will bathe you in sunlight until you are like the dawn bursting through a dark night. And then suddenly your healing will manifest. You will see your righteousness march out before you, and the glory of Yahweh will protect you from all harm! TPT

Psalm 91 ² <u>I will say of the LORD</u>, "<u>He is my refuge and my fortress</u>; <u>My God</u>, <u>in Him I will</u> <u>trust</u>." ⁹ Because you have made the LORD, who is my refuge, Even the Most High, your dwelling</u> place, ¹⁰ <u>No evil shall befall you</u>, <u>Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling</u>; ¹¹ For <u>He</u> <u>shall give His angels charge over you</u>, To keep you in all your ways. ¹⁴ "Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My name. ¹⁵ He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; <u>I will deliver</u> <u>him and honor him</u>. ¹⁶ <u>With long life I will satisfy him</u>, <u>And show him My salvation</u>." NKJV

Mark 10 ¹³ The parents kept bringing their little children to Jesus so that he would lay his hands on them *and bless them*. But the disciples kept rebuking and scolding the people for doing it. ¹⁴ When Jesus saw what was happening, he became indignant with his disciples and said to them, "Let all the little children come to me and never hinder them! Don't you know that God's kingdom exists for such as these? ¹⁵ Listen to the truth I speak: Whoever does not open their arms to receive God's kingdom like a teachable child will never enter it." ¹⁶ <u>Then he embraced each</u> <u>child</u>, <u>and laying his hands on them</u>, <u>he lovingly blessed each one</u>.
